

We are pleased to announce the **UK Film Council 2007 Film Publications Fund** will be launched on **Friday 15th June**.

Following the first three years of the Publications Fund a review was conducted in 2006/7 to ascertain the ongoing viability of the Fund.

In 2007/08 the UK Film Council Film Publications Fund will invite applications from print and on-line film-related publications predominantly aimed at the film industry.

The Fund aims to encourage debate about issues which challenge the perception of film and the film industry by broadening readership, increasing editorial range and

developing the sustainability of film-related publications.

In 2007/08 the UK Film Council will be accepting two levels of applications:

One for awards under £10,000; we would expect these to be from small companies or individuals who may have a high risk project, or need seed funding to support a start up venture.

One for awards over £10,000; more likely to be awarded to already existing publications with a new project or new projects which can demonstrate their viability or are particularly innovative and ambitious.

Applications for under £10,000 will only be accepted from individuals, companies, charities and other incorporated organisations.

Applications for over £10,000 will only be accepted from limited companies, charities and other incorporated organisations.
